## Nursery

## Class 2 Topic - 'Do We Shape The Environment?' Trips

We really like to go out of school and ensure that the children have the opportunity to experience visits that deepen their learning. Class 2 will visit the Stone Centre as part of their learning. We will also be visiting the Heights of Abraham to find out about lead mining and the impact it had on Derbyshire.

## Class 1 Topic - 'How Do We Build A Community?'

We will be heading into Crich to find out how the local community is supported. We will also be using local transport to visit Matlock and Derby. We will be discovering the differences between villages, towns and cities and finding out how communities are supported there.

## Safer Internet Day - Tuesday February 11th

We will be running a parent workshop on how to keep your child safe online. The workshop will run from 9am - 9.30am and will be held in the downstairs classroom. We will also be organising a range of activities for the children throughout the week to help them keep safe.

## Uniform
